The Osler Award annually recognizes a medical student, a resident in Internal Medicine, and a practicing physician of any specialty. Recipients will be honored at a Spokane Society of Internal Medicine event each calendar year.

The Osler Award recognizes humanistic values of compassion, courage, altruism, kindness, and integrity in bedside patient-care medicine, done in a manner that enhances role-modeling for the community. Nominations should describe the nominee’s actions, behaviors, and example-setting which embody professionalism and compassion.

Nominations for all categories may be submitted by medical students of any school who are in rotations in Spokane, by Internal Medicine residents, or by community physicians. Community Physicians recognized may be of ANY specialty.

Selections of nominees are made by the SSIM Executive Committee, with a simple-majority voting method.
